SoTL Cluster:

Organizing to Foster the Scholarship of Teaching and Learning Final Action Plan Status Report – Spring 2006

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Overview

The purpose of this cluster is to enhance the support for, value and recognition of, and practical application of the scholarship of teaching and learning (SoTL) on core member campuses. Institutions (i.e. core members) committed to this purpose include the following:

Creating a culture on each campus where the role of the faculty, both individually and collectively, is viewed in a more comprehensive and integrated way, where equal respect and reward is given to faculty members who emphasize the scholarship of teaching and learning as those who engage in disciplinary scholarship, is central to our mission as a cluster. The implications of this mission are that the cluster must engage in activities that take advantage of the diverse cultures and resources of the core member institutions and conduct activities that will support SoTL on individual campuses. Representatives of each core member will contribute to the health of the cluster by adhering to the following principles of association.

- Maintain communication with other members including sharing information on the AAHE Web Center
- Build support for the work of the cluster on core member campuses
- Develop and share resource materials to assist other members in their efforts
- Disseminate ideas and outcomes of the cluster's work in other settings (e.g., AAHE summer academy, CASTL colloquium, professional association meetings, individual campuses)

The core members of the cluster propose the following **action items**.

- 1. Share SoTL resources with other members of the cluster
- 2. Conduct assessments to document the work of the cluster and development of SoTL at core member institutions
- 3. Disseminate information on the work of the cluster to core member institutions and constituents external to the cluster
- 4. Share and develop strategies for promoting SoTL at core member institutions
- 5. Pursue external funding to support the work of the cluster
- 6. Create an electronic data base of SoTL researchers
- 7. Establish the call for proposals and evaluation criteria for the Cluster Scholars Collaborative Grant Program

- 8. Create a document of preferred example language about SoTL for annual evaluation and tenure and promotion guidelines
- 9. Develop strategies to promote SoTL at the Departmental and Campus levels with recommendations for administrative support.
- 10. Submit and present cluster related work at multiple conferences.
- 11. Create an on-line resource packet of cluster products.
